HOW TO APPLY SMART MAGNETIC WHITEBOARD WALLPAPERS

Smart Magnetic Whiteboard Wallpaper

Smart Magnetic Whiteboard Wallpaper - Low Sheen

Use care when handling your Smart Magnetic Whiteboard Wallpapers. Ensure you do not crease or fold over the material as you may damage the surface. We recommend that you wear gloves.

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HOW TO PREPARE WALLS FOR WALLPAPER APPLICATION

- Cover the floor with plastic or other suitable protection material.
- Check and fill any holes or cracks in the surface with a normal decorators filler.
- Remove all previous wallpapers or old / loose paint.
- Use abrasive paper to sand smooth and rough or uneven surfaces.
- Absorbent surfaces should be treated with a primer, such as Smart White Primer, before the application of your Smart Magnetic Whiteboard Wallpaper.

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MEASURE & MARK

- We recommend horizontal application of the wallpaper, starting with the bottom section of the wall.
- With a pencil, mark a straight, level and horizontal line across the wall, 1.22cm off the floor. This will guide the top edge of the first section of wallpaper.
- Measure the wallpaper to the desired length and cut with a sharp blade or sharp scissors.

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HOW TO APPLY ADHESIVE

- A Vinyl over Vinyl adhesive is required to install Smart Magnetic Whiteboard Wallpapers. Standard wallpaper adhesives are not suitable.
- Stir the adhesive before use. If the adhesive is very thick or viscous, add upto 2.5% - 5% water until it's smooth.
- Apply one generous coat of vinyl over vinyl adhesive to the wall with a roller and brush for the edges. Do not over-apply the adhesive.

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APPLY MAGNETIC WHITEBOARD WALLPAPER

First length of material:

- Starting in a corner, install the bottom section first, roll the wallpaper out along the wall, use your pencil line at 1.22cm as a guide.
- Carefully roll out the wallpaper along the wall pushing any air and excess adhesive out from behind the material as you go.
- Using a wallpaper spatula, press the entire surface of the wallpaper to the wall, pushing out all the excess wallpaper adhesive from behind the material.
- Use a consistent and strong pressure to ensure all air bubbles and excess adhesive have been pushed out to the edges.

Next length of material:

- For jointing the material, we recommend you butt the material together. The material is supplied with clean straight edges which will meet evenly.
- It is important to hang the lower section first so the section applied above will naturally sit on the lower section.
- The material will meet and can be worked together with a wallpaper spatula. Work the material by applying upwards and downwards pressure to each section along the joint bringing them together.
- If an area of the joint requires additional attention, add extra adhesive and continue to work together.
- If the joint / seam is not flat, gently lift the edge of one section of the wallpaper off the wall and guide the material to slot together and work again with spatula. You may need to add a small amount of extra adhesive.
- Check the entire surface of the wallpaper for any excess adhesive or air pockets and push out to an edge with a spatula.
- Repeat this process for the entire installation of the wallpaper.
- Once wallpaper installation is complete, wipe the entire surface clean with a damp cloth to remove any excess adhesive residue. Finally inspect for any air bubbles.

Note

You can overlap and double cut the material if required. Cut the material at angles such as a 90 degree wall corner.

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ALLOW TO DRY

Smart Magnetic Whiteboard Wallpapers should not be used for 48 hours following installation to allow adhesive to fully dry.

Using your Smarter Surface

- For best results, we recommend using high quality accessories, such as those available on our website or from your local Smarter Surfaces partner.
- Clean on a regular basis with a [microfibre cloth](#) and our cleaning fluids as required.
- Use neodymium magnets such as [Smart Neo-Magnets](#) on magnetic wallpapers.
